
Regulations

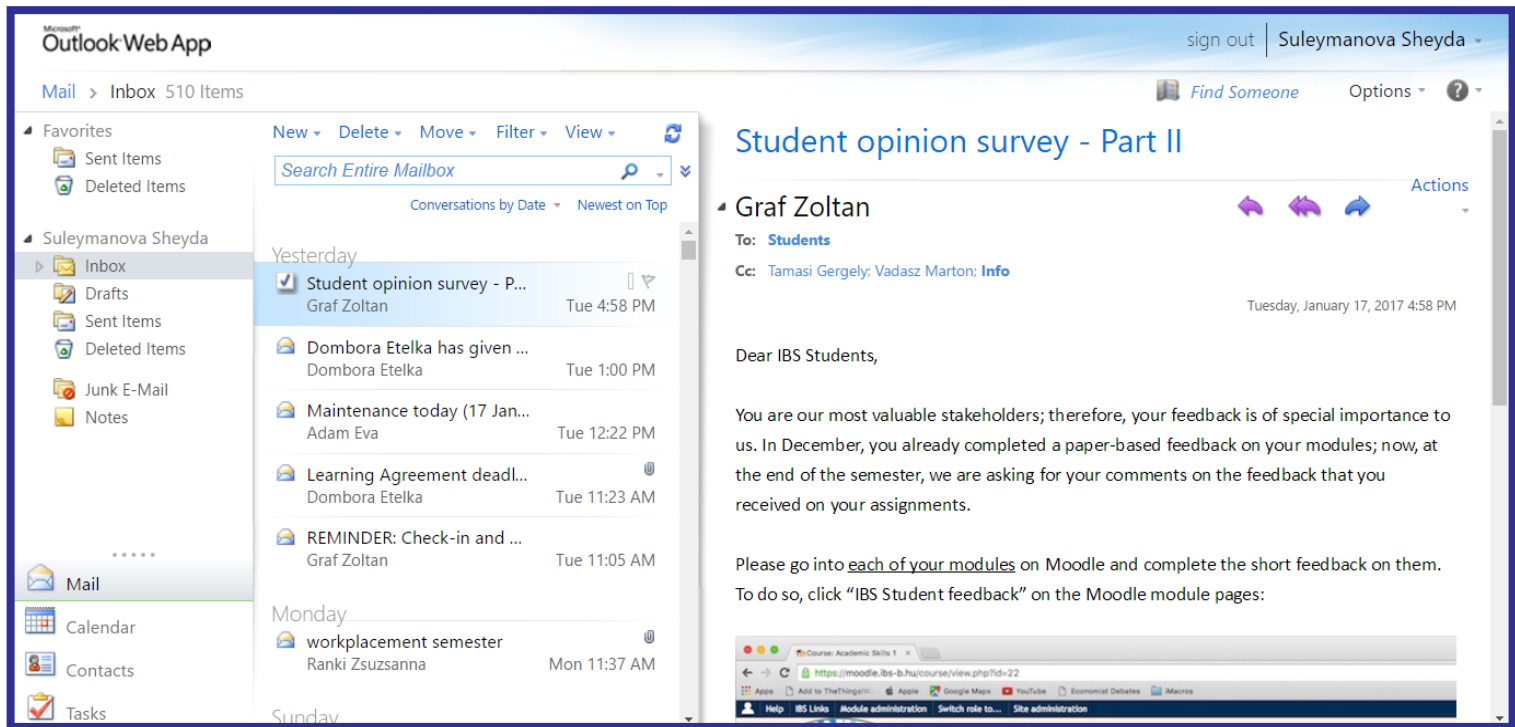

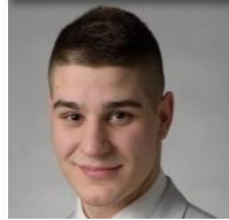

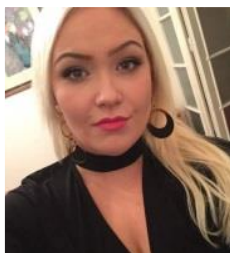

Sightseeing

Buda Castle: is the historical castle and palace complex of the Hungarian kings in Budapest, and was first completed in 1265. In the past, it has been called Royal Palace and Royal Castle.



Széchenyi Thermal Bath: largest medicinal bath in Europe.



Chain Bridge: The Széchenyi Chain Bridge is a suspension bridge that spans the River Danube between Buda and Pest, the western and eastern sides of Budapest. Designed by the English Engineer William Tierney Clark, it was the first permanent bridge across the Danube in Hungary, and was opened in 1849.



Heroes' Square: Hősök tere is one of the major squares in Budapest, noted for its iconic statue complex featuring the Seven Chieftains of the Magyars and other important national leaders, as well as the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.



Matthias Church: Mátyás-templom is a Roman Catholic church located in Budapest, in front of the Fisherman's Bastion in the heart of the Buda Castle District.



Fisherman's Bastion: The Halászbástya is a terrace in neo-Gothic and neo-Romanesque style located on the Buda bank of the Danube, on the Castle hill in Budapest, around Matthias Church. It was designed and built between 1895 and 1902 on the plans of Frigyes Schulek.



St. Stephen's Basilica: Szent István-Bazilika is a Roman Catholic basilica in Budapest. It is named in honour of Stephen, the first King of Hungary.



Vajdahunyad Castle: is a castle in the City Park of Budapest. The castle was designed by Ignác Alpár to feature copies of several landmark buildings from different parts the Kingdom of Hungary, especially the Hunyad Castle in Transylvania (now in Romania).



Hungarian Parliament Building: is the seat of the National Assembly of Hungary, one of Europe's oldest legislative buildings, a notable landmark of Hungary and a popular tourist destination of Budapest.



Shoes on the Danube Bank: is a memorial in Budapest. Conceived by film director Can Togay, who created it on the east bank of the Danube River with sculptor Gyula Pauer to honor the people (mainly Budapest Jews) who were killed by fascist Arrow Cross militiamen in Budapest during World War II.



Hungarian State Opera House: Magyar Állami Operaház is a neo-Renaissance opera house located in central Budapest, on Andrásy út. Originally known as the Hungarian Royal Opera House, it was designed by Miklós Ybl, a major figure of 19th century Hungarian architecture.



Gellert Hill: Gellért-hegy is a 235m high hill overlooking the Danube in Budapest. The Gellért Hill was named after Saint Gerard, who was thrown to death from the hill.



Great Market Hall: or Central Market Hall is the largest and oldest indoor market in Budapest.



Hungarian National Museum: Magyar Nemzeti Múzeum was founded in 1802 and is the national museum for the history, art and archaeology of Hungary.



Transportation

Budapest has a fairly extensive and efficient public transport system. It is also cheaper than in most Western European cities.

A wide variety of trams, buses, trolleys and metro trains run in the city. Night service is quite reliable, too.

The **metro lines** are only running **until 23.30** every day. The **night buses** start running as soon as the metro stops. The most important **tram line (4&6)** is running **24/7**.

Be prepared for typical rush hours: vehicles are crowded and traffic can be rather slow. This would be expected in any large city



As students, we would like to advise you to buy **student pass** (berlet) which costs 3450HUF and can be bought on **ticket machines** which can be found on bus/tram/metro stations. In addition, there are specialized ticket selling offices on all major metro stations. **IMPORTANT!!** Before purchasing student pass, make sure that you have taken your (temporary) **student card from Student Center** at IBS. This piece of paper contains a very important number without which you would not be able to purchase student ticket, and of course keep this paper together with your ticket.

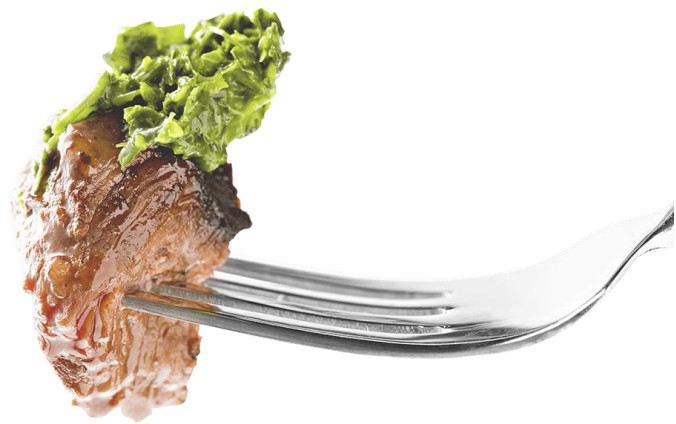

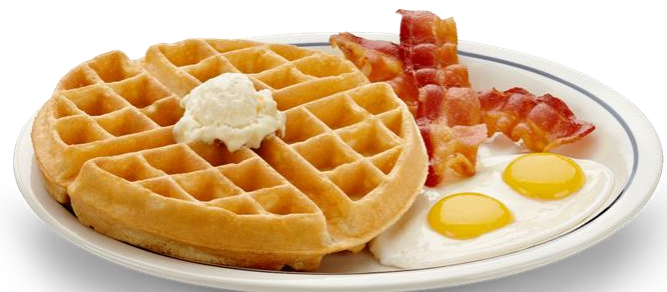

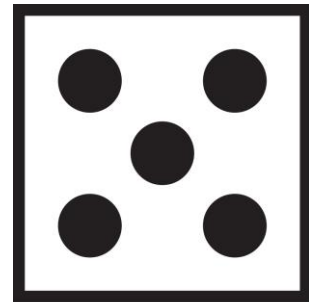

Emergency Numbers

- **112** - common emergency number
In addition to Hungarian, the call can be answered in English, German and in some cases in Romanian. It is possible to call 112 from a mobile phone even without a SIM card. The 112 operator can detect the location of the caller within about 3 seconds.
- **104** - ambulance & emergency medical services,
- **105** - fire-brigade, rescue services, civil protection
- **107** – police
